

Fourth my Main Concern. is the fatal impact this will have on the Warwickshire Exhibition centre, This will close, As the Gypsy Site will be only yards from the Building, and their Caravans parked in what is used as a car Park for all visiting the Exhibition centre. 33,000 People visited the centre in 2012, with even more Exhibitions Booked for this year and Next. With even more foot-fall expected for the coming years. Free Buses into Leamington which also helps our local Shops, Pubs, Restaurants ect ect. How can you risk the loss of such a great footfall when Leamington is already a Struggling Town. I know as I was made redundant in Feb this year when Dorothy Perkins/Burton closed its doors. This was also due to lack of Trade.
