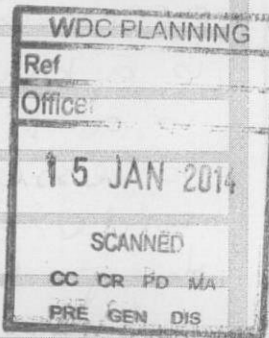

Of all the 5 preferred options 4 of them rely on access to the main road via the junction by The Anchor. In the 29 years of living here we have had two plans to develop down this road, one an NCH home in Walter Close and one for the village school in The Paddock. Both were rejected and a major factor was this access via a very dangerous junction. There is a bend, causing many 'near misses'. There is a narrow path where crossing the road is essential, the road cannot be made wider because of housing, the deliveries to the pub are made on that corner + there is often a queue of traffic waiting to get out. I am surprised there has not been a death here. Woodside lane has increasingly been used as a Rat Run and speeding is common.

To increase the village by nearly 25% is totally unreasonable. I am all in favour of building for the young. It is necessary, but to this scale - the village will no longer exist - even if there is a 'gap' between us and Kenilworth.
