1.	Any development on site 1 will forever damage the setting for the Church and surrounding listed buildings which is enjoyed by villagers and visitors alike.		
2.	The site proposed for development is open countryside that helps define the village and ensure separation from the Leamington Spa, it is one of the last remaining spaces in the village. This will be lost forever.		
3.	Site 1 is north of the A425 and is separated from the main part of the village and all the local amenities. It is not a natural extension of the village.		
4.	As a mother of two small children that attend the local primary school I know how dangerous the traffic on the A425 can be. Children who need to go to school and other residents wishing to access the local amenities would have to cross the main road. If the issue could somehow be mitigated then it would presumably impact the traffic on the A425 causing further congestion in the village. In addition any mitigation would damage the setting of the Church and other listed buildings.		
5.	Building 100 houses in the middle of the village will surely mean another 200 cars exiting right into the heart of the village at the rush hours further adding to the traffic issues. If site 2 were developed then at least some of the traffic from the development would exit towards the Fosse Way and therefore not exacerbate the current traffic issues.		
6.	I see stansgate are planning a balancing pool by the Church. Has anyone thought about the young children and clubs like the Brownies that use the Church? This could be very dangerous,
