2. We still have to put up with occasional smells from the Sewage farm
3. Aylesford school is almost on the site you are considering, the problems of access prior to residents and people who have to pass through the town to get to work
4. Access into the town is very poor as you are aware due to the river and the racecourse. Caravans passing through the

team is the last thing Warwick wishes for
5. Individual rites, which the proposal
contemplates, has far less relevance
than community rites which applies to
the vast majority and should be given
consideration.
