*RE site H53 (Brownley Green Lane):

- The use of green belt land for development goes against government recommendations and is wrong.
- The requirement for a large number of additional houses isn't an 'exceptional circumstance' and should have been planned for more effectively. Deviating from national policy in this way is irreparable, unacceptable & unsustainable.
- The use of this area of green belt land would be detrimental to the ecological diversity of the area, would be harmful for established trees and other wildlife and goes against the sympathetic nature of the current development.
- Development of this area would contribute to urban sprawl towards other dwellings and the natural boundary with the Lane. It would also set a precedent for future development of the adjacent land and poses a privacy issue for residents whose properties overlook the current green belt surrounding Hatton Park.
- Access from Barcheston drive is limited at best: traffic calming measures, current traffic volumes and on street parking all hinder the viability of this as an access route for both residents and construction traffic.
- The proposed access route to the site involves a steep gradient and much of the site's volume would need to be devoted to providing access with a shallow gradient. Development of the site would lead to multiple 'levels' of development which would not be in keeping with the architectural merit of the current site.
- The proposed access route cuts across the newly extended village hall car park and no proposals have been made for this to be moved. The recreational facilities and community orchard next to the hall must not be disturbed.
- No adequate provision has been put forward for schooling, highways, amenity provision and flood mitigation.

 - Site H53 should be removed from the proposed local plan as it is not justified, effective, or in line with national policy.
 - The housing volume of site H53 should be absorbed within the H28 site (which could be expanded to fill the entire plot of 7.8h). The housing density within the H28 site should closely align to that of the rest of the Hatton Park development and include adequate recreational green space. Additionally, the architectural merit of the properties within the site should be in harmony with the rest of the Hatton park development.
 - Consideration must be made for the additional traffic servicing site H28 and measures to increase the capacity of the Birmingham Road must be made.
