**H50** – The proposed site contravenes National Planning Policy Framework as it is in a green belt area. There appears to be no justification to alter this under the ruling of ""exceptional circumstances. It will also impinge on the proposed HS2 rail plan - adding to the known landscape issues.

The topography of the combined areas H50-H25 and H26 could result in sewage and surface water overwhelming the recently installed new system around the lower reaches of the village. This relates to my further comment below.

Developers may not come forward or be able to build dwellings at a reasonable price due to the need to install a complex and substantial drainage system. The adjacent HS2 system will also reflect on realistic market values to encourage the much needed younger generation in order to sustain social growth within the village.


There are serious issues with the existing road systems around this area. The B4453 would require two roundabouts to be built. One at Windmill Hill and one at the junction of Church lane and Rugby road – the latter to slow down what is now a recognised "RAT RUN" between Coventry and Offchurch.

Finally, within the Village there is a fear that large scale developments around Lillington and our boundaries may in the "bigger picture" cause Cubbington to lose its identity or even be merged with Leamington.!


