The maps concerned show development to include the west bank of Radford / Whitnash Brook.

There is no ~~attempt~~ / indication of the extension of the Wildlife Reserve corridor from the limit of the existing development ^{at Syleham} to the Regia Via (traverse from Whitnash to Radford Semele).

Additionally I feel that this should also be continued south to the limit of development from the Regia Via.

Nothing is indicated on your plan for this.

The absence of wildlife / green corridor does I feel contradict your sections on Green Infrastructure and also The Historic Environment.

It is well documented that the bank of Whitnash Brook to the south of Regia Via contains archaeological remains dating back to the Middle Ages as does, it is thought the land itself. (Refer to County Archaeologist).

* CHANGES: Indicate a broad swathe on bank of Brook to continue Wildlife Reserve, and green linear park to southernmost extent of Whitnash East development.

I object to W.D.C. opposing HS2.

This project is in the National Interest and should not be blocked by 'localism'.

It will provide essential long distance, high speed capacity to the railway network which is overloaded on the line to Euston. The Marylebone line is slow/medium speed and is also used by slow freight trains. Construction will provide employment & boost local economy.

Without HS2 the long distance traffic levels on the M40 will only increase. The M40 is very full most of the day.

Living at Sydenham we experience a significant amount of noise from the M40 traffic, most of which does not originate locally.

HS2 will not generate noise of any appreciable level. I have much experience of TGV lines in France.
