The village is insufficiently well-connected to local towns, and the village school (very successful) would be unable to cope with the resulting number of new pupils. The allocation of houses to Cat. 1 villages should not be made a 'blanket' allocation but take into account the present population as well as the infrastructure of the village.

It will also result in the risk of further infill. Please consider limiting the size of the development and utilising other sites.
