The table identifies where the key housing allocations are to be made, which includes land at Red House Farm. King Henry VIII Charity and Sir Thomas White's Charity jointly own part of the land and confirm that the land is available for development. They strongly support the proposed allocation of 250 dwellings to the Red House Farm site.

The Charities also support the proposed designation of land for housing on the edge of Cubbington, which is rightly identified in the Draft Settlement Hierarchy Report 2013 as one of the most sustainable villages. Its size and level of sustainability mean it would be able to accommodate up to 150 dwellings during the Plan period without detriment to the overall operation, character or appearance of the settlement. They particularly consider that land to the south west of Windmill Hill, adjacent to the Sports and Social Club, would be most appropriate.
