I ask myself what possible benefit would be received to our Ancient Village? In addition to the cogent points already put to you by our Parish Council. I would ask the following questions.

- 1. What possible benefit to us.
- 2. A. Would their presence increase their attendance in the many local activities listed in the back of the Parish Magazine, The W.I. for instance, the allotment society, The British Legion club, they really need new playing members! What about the regular Art class held in the Village Hall, or the Allotment association, (they may be interest in the vegetables!)

Our beautiful Parish church is also in need of new blood (but not an overt interest in its priceless Parish Plate) Can we look forward to help in maintaining the cemetery, well done by

Volunteers? Has the W.D.C. any answers to the above questions, Have indeed their (the Travellers view been sought?) I am sure the residents of Baginbun have a right to know, if only to plan for extra seats at their meetings.

In short would the establishment of a site be of positive benefit to the wellbeing of our Village, we have a right to know, before such an application is approved.

On a personal level I am an Eighty Four year old pensioner, a war veteran, suffering from Alzheimers, who is looking for a quiet life. Our rented property, located at the West end of the Village is vulnerable, we have already experienced a robbery which resulted in the loss of some £2,000 of Victorian jewelry belonging to my wife a robbery which was aided by inadequate rotten downstairs rear windows with poor latches (since rectified at last by the Housing Association) so we have had first hand experience of Petty Crime. Whilst I admit, this was not, in the view of the Police the result of Travellers.

It does not increase our enthusiasm for your above proposal. In short.

It is entirely inappropriate development for our area. And we strongly disapprove of it.
