

- * Where have the figures for 6630 new dwellings in the next 15 years come from? If each household has at least 2 people working that's ~~13260~~ 13,260 jobs need to be created in the area. Is that likely? If the jobs are created ~~outside~~ in e.g. Coventry or areas outside Warwick District, the people will be driving to work which will increase car pollution in the area.
- * All brownfield sites should be used for development before any green sites are considered.
- * Developments in villages should not be considered as they don't have the facilities e.g. shops, doctors etc. This means that people have to drive for facilities.
- * Any development south of Warwick over Leamington Spa means driving through Warwick or on Leamington to get North for work. The District Council need to look at all the traffic queues in the area during rush hour - how can 13,260 extra cars (2 per dwelling) be driven on existing roads.
