I OBJECT TO THE 100 PROPOSED HOUSE ON THICKTHORN KENILWORTH. THIS FIRSTLY IS TOO MANY HOUSES BEING IMPOSED ON KENILWORTH, ESPECIALLY WHEN THERE IS THE THREAT OF HS2 BEING BUILT AND THE ADDITIONAL DESTRUCTION OF GREENFIELD LAND IN THE VERY IMPORTANT LAND BETWEEN KENILWORTH AND COVENTRY. I OBJECT MOST STRONGLY ABOUT HOUSE BEING BUILT IN ONE AREA + GREENFIELD LAND. THERE COULD BE A FEW HOUSES BUILT AROUND SEVERAL AREAS IN KENILWORTH BUT CERTAINLY NOT ALL IN THIS ONE AREA AND NOT THIS AMOUNT (100 WOULD BE A MAXIMUM NUMBER THAT WOULD PROBABLY NOT CHANGE THE CHARACTER OF THE TOWN AND NEED EXTRA FACILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE). THE GREENFIELD AREA BEING PROPOSED IS USED AS LEISURE FACILITIES FOR WALKERS CYCLISTS ETC AND SHOULD BE SAVED FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS. WARWICK DISTRICT COUNCIL WOULD BE WISE TO LISTEN TO THE RESIDENTS VIEWS THAT THE VAST MAJORITY OF KENILWORTH RESIDENTS (AND WDC IN GENERAL) WOULD PREFER THE LOWEST OPTION OF GROWTH - OPTION 1.
