- 1) THE LAND IN THIS CASE IS OWNED BY CABBINGTON FREEHOLDERS ON BEHALF OF THE PARISH OF CABBINGTON. THE INCOME FROM THE LAND HAS BEEN USED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PARISH AND VILLAGE BASED COMMUNITY ORGANISATIONS. LOSS OF THIS INCOME WILL AFFECT THE PARISH. THE PROCEEDS OF ANY COMPULSORY PURCHASE ARE UNLIKELY TO BE ABLE TO BE INVESTED AND GIVE A SIMILAR RETURN. THIS WILL BE A LOSS TO THE PARISH.
- 2) THE PROPOSED SITE JOINS A VERY BUSY ROAD AT A DIFFICULT SPOT. LEICESTER LANE / RYTON ROAD HAVE HAD SEVERAL ACCIDENTS, SOME FATAL, THE NUMBER OF PROPOSED PITCHES FOR THE SITE AND THE VOLUME OF VEHICLES ASSOCIATED WITH THOSE PITCHES WILL INCREASE THE RISK OF ACCIDENTS.

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
