- 1) There are bats at my property, New Farm, who live in the loft and have done so for the past 40 years. I also believe that there are bats in the surrounding area, which is in the proposed area of development, living in local barns, trees and woods. A development of Option 1 would be most detrimental to the local bat population. Roosts could be under threat and there would be disruption to bat foraging and commuting habitat which would affect the bats ability to survive.

1. I suggest that a survey is carried out in the Option 1 area to determine the presence of bats. They are a protected species by law.
2. Housing development should not be concentrated in one area but spread out throughout the village.
3. Development would create traffic congestion at Hylkane.
