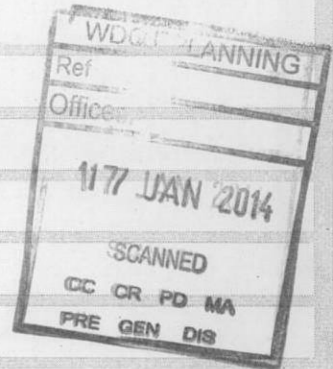

The proposed Gladman (site 1) retains all the same Characteristics already firmly rejected by the Council as part of its own detailed planning analysis, except for the fact that the traffic has almost doubled since the nineties.

Offchurch Lane is already gridlocked between 8 and 9am making it dependent on the good nature of queuing motorist to allow us to exit our drive. This situation will undoubtedly worsen with the proposed housing increases in Southam and surrounding district. Building on site 1 would make the access through Radford Semele totally impossible.

We recommend site Nos 2 & 3 (As recommended by the Parish Council) These sites not only meet the current Housing needs but also offer space for future potential needs. Furthermore these sites have direct access to the Fosse Way, Gayden and the M40 thus reducing the traffic passing through Radford Semele. A simple extension to the 30mph speed limit would give access to and from sites 2 & 3 at a minimal cost compared to the major road changes required for Site 1.

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
