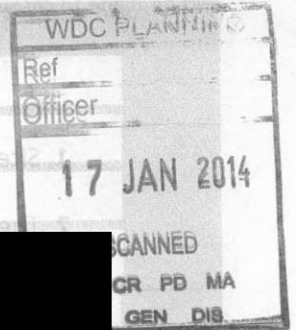

1. Site number 1 will cause the least long term disruption to the village as a whole.
2. The majority of the functional, rather than aesthetic, objections will apply equally to the other potential sites and particularly surface water drainage which is already grossly inadequate for sites 2, 3, & 4.
