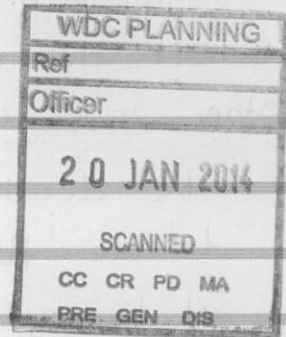

I support the building of houses on preferred option 1 (land South of the school for the following reasons:-

- 1) It is a site far better suited for development to become an integral part of the village community, near to amenities, the school etc, and would not become just an "add on" as other proposed sites.
- 2) The development could be carefully planned with reference to the Parish Council Plan to build a suitable number of homes, and space to extend the village school as required.
- 3) A new entrance to the school could be created off Oakley wood road, thus relieving the ongoing problem of cars and coaches negotiating the narrow roads through the village to reach the school gates.
- 4) The development would have less visual impact due to its location, and less invasion of privacy, and M40 noise pollution than any other proposed sites.
- 5) New traffic could use Oakley wood road to access the M40 and Reamington/Warwick without further congesting the village, and the already dangerous Malloy Road/Banbury Road junction.

If we are forced to have housing developments in the village, I would support the alteration of the boundary to the south of the village (preferred option 1) as the only viable extension. However, the new boundary shown on page 39, in my opinion extends too far west. The narrow "extra" western area should be changed by extending the line running south along Holt Avenue to meet the southern perimeter. See diagram.
