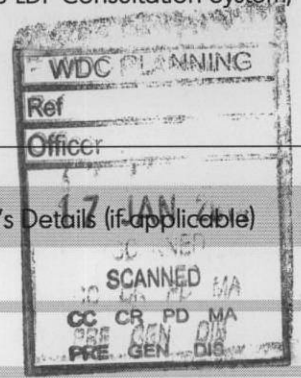

(5) WITH INCREASED HOUSING IN THE VILLAGE, PARKING FOR VILLAGE SCHOOL DROP OFF & COLLECT WILL BECOME EVEN BUSIER. SITE 5, THE INFORMAL CAR PARK, IS ALREADY USED AS AN 'OVERSPILL' FROM THE CURRENT SCHOOL CAR PARK. SOLUTION IS TO MAKE THIS A PERMANENT SCHOOL EXTENSION PARKING AREA.

WARRICK ROAD T JUNCTION AT WARRICK ROAD / WOODCOTE LANE IS ALREADY BUSY AND ACCIDENTS & NUMEROUS NEAR MISSES HAVE OCCURRED DUE TO POOR VISIBILITY PULLING ONTO THE MAIN WARRICK ROAD. INCREASED HOUSING IN THE VILLAGE AND INCREASED THROUGH TRAFFIC WILL ENHANCE THIS RISK. TO IGNORE THIS WOULD I BELIEVE BE BOTH DANGEROUS & IRRESPONSIBLE. SOLUTION WOULD BE TO REDESIGN THE JUNCTION AND BRING PROPER TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES INTO THE VILLAGE.

(7-13) IF 80 DWELLINGS ARE APPROVED, NO FURTHER APPLICATIONS ON SITES 7-13 SHOULD BE ACCEPTED. TO DO SO WOULD a) DESTROY THE ESSENCE OF THE VILLAGE b) BE DISPROPORTIONATELY LARGE FOR THE ROAD INFRASTRUCTURE AS IT STANDS

(8,11,13) THERE ARE ALREADY SERIOUS PROBLEMS WITH DRAINAGE/SEWERAGE ALONG 'THE HAMLET'. THIS REQUIRES SERIOUS CONSIDERATION REGARDING SITES 8,11,13.

WARRICK ROAD MANY FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN AT THE VILLAGE SCHOOL WALK ALONG ALREADY NARROW PAVEMENTS ALONG WARRICK ROAD. INCREASED THROUGH TRAFFIC WILL NECESSITATE TRAFFIC CALMING AND WIDENING OF PEDESTRIAN & CYCLE ROUTES.
