- 1 Object to Site 1 on the following grounds
- 1/ Affecting the Heritage Setting of the Grade 2 listed church of St Nicholas
  - 2/ That the effect of an additional 120 houses will create considerable traffic problems on Soubar Road
  - 3/ The site is remote from local shops/services
  - 4/ There are archaeological remains in the field including a medieval surker village
  - 5/ The site is prone to High levels of surface water flooding as identified on the Environment Agency flood risk site. Building more houses will exacerbate the flooding problem
  - 6/ The site is significant in terms of ecology, bats are visible every year. Other wildlife includes newts, snakes, roe deer, and foxes. Flocks of Canada Geese visit the site every autumn. Moles and mice also live in the field.
- Site 2 is a much more preferable site in terms of lower visual impact and better highway accessibility
