We object to Site no 1. This is an attractive rural setting with the church historically viewed across the open fields. As regards access to the development, it is already difficult to access the main road from School Lane and also Offchurch Lane. We would recommend sites no 2 and 3 due to less impact to the village if there was a small development either side of the main road. Traffic would also not be joining the main road at the same place that 2 other roads gain access causing considerable congestion, especially at significant times of the day.
