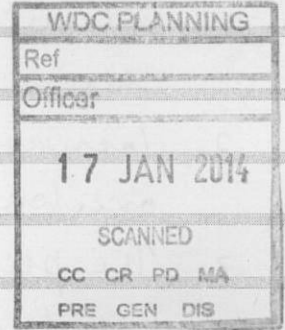

### Housing development in Radford Semete.

#### Option 1 - objections to development.

1. Detrimental visual impact destroying the historic church environs & the open feel of the village.
2. Increased concentration of traffic on an already overloaded section of Southam Road.

#### Option 2 (and 1 or 3) - positive points
