CONSIDER THE PROTECTED AND LISTED BUILDINGS, ALL PART OF THE HISTORY AND HERITAGE OF RADFORD SEMELE THE NORMAN CHURCH RECENTLY REBUILT AFTER ARSON ATTACK IT STANDS IN CHURCH FIELDS & SITE OF ORIGINAL VILLAGE THE PROPOSED ACCESS TO THE SITE IS RESTRICTED TO ONE REAL ACCESS, THE TEMPORARY EMERGENCY ONE IN OFF CHURCH LANE, WITH NORMAL FAST HEAVY TRAFFIC.
