I refer to the proposed site for gypsy / travellers off the Stratford Road, Warwick, a site which will be bordered by the River Avon, Water treatment plant, M40 motorway and access from the main Warwick to Stratford Rd which is often grid-locked approaching the Longbridge Island. There are occasions when my husband and I have to (if we are able) three point turn to join the queue to drive through the town which is no mean feat when traffic is static due to the hindrance of the "traffic calming" or 'pedestrian friendly' which have been introduced. Personally I would call it traffic calamity, (lorries, ambulances, fire engines I have witnessed having tremendous problems! Pedestrians parking their cars on Courthouse side of Jewry St / High St. having to cross main road 3 times to access town, due to parking ticket machines situation.) Thank you for the pedestrian crossing! After all the alterations & costs involved, I would hope that lessons were learned and that we are not heading into another traffic decision that will add more problems for year Warwick residents.
