Policy DS16 for the Sub-Regional Employment Site has not been subject to the sustainability appraisal. The Coventry and Warwickshire Strategic Employment Land Study only assesses the need for employment and does not assess the sustainability of the proposed sites, specifically, the impact on the natural environment and biodiversity has not been considered.

The lack of Sustainability Appraisal for this policy makes it unjustified and therefore unsound, as there may be alternative sites in the sub-region which meet employment needs and perform better against the sustainability objectives.

There has been no assessment of the likely significant effects on the environment (Annex I (f) and footnote, European Directive 2001/42/EC) and no provisions of reasons for selecting this site over alternatives (Annex I (h)), and no measures envisaged to prevent, reduce and as fully as possible offset any significant adverse effects on the environment (Annex I (g)). As such the Trust believes that there is no justification for allocating this site in the Local Plan.

With this in mind, we believe that it is necessary for the local authority to provide robust justification for the Coventry Gateway allocation to demonstrate why the proposal was the preferred option and how it, and subsequently the local plan, contributes towards sustainable development in accordance with NPPF principles. We therefore recommend that the local authority:

- 1) Ensure the environmental evidence collated for the Coventry Gateway application is used to evaluate the scheme against the district's Sustainability objectives using the Sustainability Appraisal methodology
- 2) Work with other authorities in the Coventry and Warwickshire LEP area to review alternative sub-regional employment sites and gather relevant environmental evidence for these options.
- 3) Demonstrate and conclude if and why the Gateway Scheme is the most appropriate and sustainable option for fulfilling the need for sub-regional employment sites using the Sustainability Appraisal process.
