The Strategic Sites to which Policy DS15 refers have very significant implications for WP and WP services. We therefore contend that the policy should refer to police infrastructure needs in relation to each strategic site, not just in relation to '*Land at Gallows Hill and The Asps*'. Unless these requirements are recognised, we consider that Policy DS15 as drafted is unjustified, inconsistent with national policy and ineffective in soundness terms.

Before continuing though, we would like to emphasise that the basis for this stance is the fact contributions to police infrastructures in Warwick District are now well established. In this respect there has been, and continues to be, positive and constructive partnership work in this area between the Council, WP and WMP. Our concerns are accordingly confined to the specific drafting of Policy DS15.
