7. Please give details of why you consider the Proposed Modifications to the Submission Warwick District Local Plan are not legally compliant or are unsound. Please be as precise as possible. Kenilworth Town Council had originally hoped that development of Green Belt land at Thickthorn would only extend to Rocky Lane, leaving most established sports facilities extant. Reluctantly the Town Council, in the previous iteration of the District Local Plan, accepted the need for housing to extend as far as Woodside with only limited educational establishments in the more sensitive area to the north of there.

These modifications now indicate that the whole area between Glasshouse Lane, Crewe Lane and the A46 is liable to be developed. In Appendix B this additional area is identified as area H40 and estimated to enable an additional 640 dwellings.

Whilst being sceptical of the actual housing needs of the District and particularly Coventry, the Town Council does accept the need for a sound local plan in accordance with the requirements of national policy. However even in the previous iteration the Council had concerns at the ability of the road infrastructure in the town to cope with the increased traffic generated by the new housing, the move of the school and the increasing commuter traffic through the area, and was concerned for the sustainability effects on residents, visitors and businesses. These modifications almost double the number of houses proposed to be built in the immediate area but yet we find no corresponding reassessment of the ability of the local roads to cope. Both Glasshouse Lane and Crewe Lane as their name implies are rural lanes and the junction with Dalehouse Lane is an awkward one.

We note that the amended Sustainability Report in Appendix IV, which confusingly refers to areas K18 and K19, states that no further SA work is required, though there is an update in Appendix III for Area K17 which appears to be the previously identified school site, though as the analysis mentions the River Avon its reliability is suspect.

The Town Council considers that there should be specific reference in Appendix A Ref: H40 under Infrastructure Requirements to the need for improved roads before any further development occurs, and for a full assessment to ensure that the proposed development is sustainable. This requires a comprehensive assessment of the cumulative effects of the various development areas now being proposed east of Kenilworth.
