Re: Building Proposals at Hampton Magna.

The proposals to build so many more houses at Hampton Magna will spoil the village atmosphere, overcrowd the amenities & clog up the roads which are already at saturation point. There is congestion at the village centre, by the shops, school, surgery, pub & community centre & there is often a build up of traffic on Old Budbrooke Road because of narrowing at the top of the hill into Hampton on the Hill, sharp bends & then single file traffic at the railway bridge, all culminating at the already very busy junction with the A4177.

The public services are barely adequate at the moment & will not cope with the proposed extra amount of building, which is astronomical. Surely it would be better to build on brownfield sites first. Has the council fully assessed all available alternative options?
