## Summary

It is important that the full housing requirement is met within the Plan period and we therefore support the inclusion of a flexibility allowance to ensure that this can happen.

We consider that the overall figure for village development should be increased.

## Discussion

We are concerned that the overall housing target for the District for the Plan period is below that which is required. Moreover we are concerned that the windfall allowance is excessive. In addition it is inevitable that some sites which are allocated will not be developed during the Plan period. The inclusion of a flexibility allowance is therefore essential to ensure that sufficient housing is actually provided to meet the needs of the District. The flexibility allowance proposed will go some way to achieving that aim, although a bigger allowance would also be supported.

Elsewhere we have made representations that the overall housing figure should be increased in ensure the needs of the District are properly met. In meeting this enlarged figure additional development should be directed toward the villages. In particular this would allow greater levels of much needed affordable housing to be provided, together with other housing to meet the needs of specific groups.
