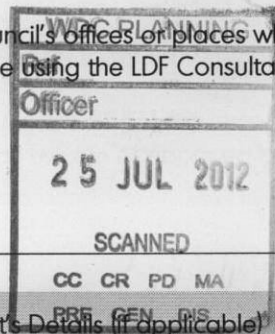

The existing infrastructure on the Banbury Road is appalling, congestion that exists between 8 AM and 9 PM and 4.30 - 5.30 often leads to the entire Road System being gridlocked for half an hour. The impact of 2700 Homes would be immense I cannot understand why a more logical line could not be drawn across Bottom of Leamington to Tachbrook Mallory ie Ste 11, rather than extending in this unnatural line into the green Belt. In addition a green corridor on the left hand side of the Road should be left of atleast 50 Meters to protect the appearance of the entrance of Warwick. 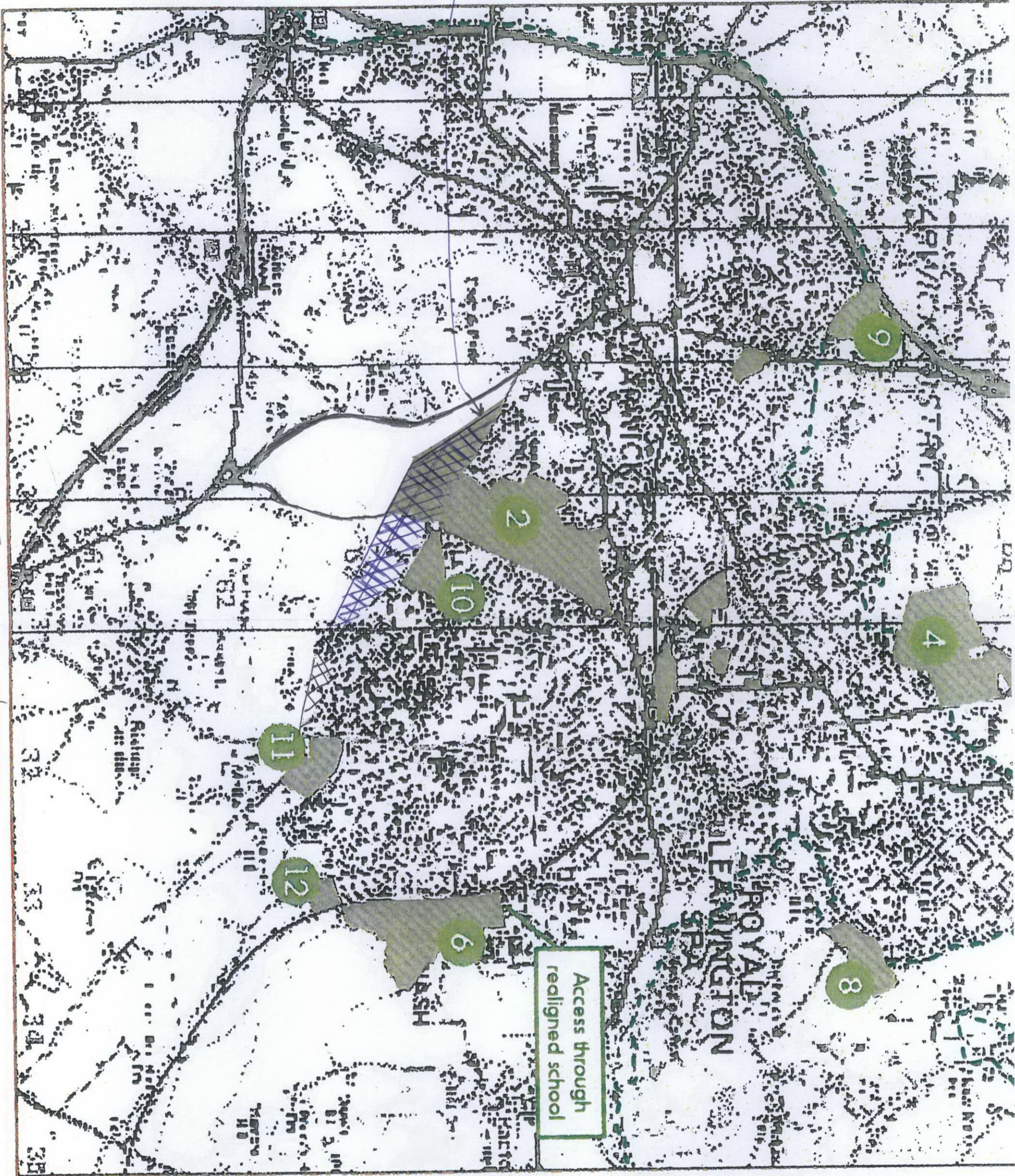
