Summary

In addition to the advantages outlined in this paragraph reference should be made to the potential gateway development around Coventry Airport and the benefits thereafter of allowing development to the north of Learnington and Warwick.

Discussion

There is a wider aim to create a new gateway focused on the Coventry airport, creating anything up to 14,000 jobs. If this comes to fruition then there will be a greater requirement for new homes to accommodate the workforce. This will inevitably be spread across a wide area, but many people are likely to choose to live in and around Warwick and Learnington. Focusing development solely on the southern side of the District will mean any staff having to travel through the centre of Warwick/Learnington with the associated adverse impact on infrastructure. Development on the northern and eastern sides of Learnington Spa will be best placed to accommodate the likely workforce with less impact on infrastructure. This additional benefit should be included within the assessment.
